

GENERAL CARE INSTRUCTIONS

We recommend the following cleaning for any of our manicure and pedicure accessories:

- A mild bleach solution (1 part bleach to 3 parts water), or
- Hospital grade disinfectant
- Use a soft non-abrasive brush or clean sponge
- We do not recommend citronella cleaning products, lemon oil, straight bleach or Barbicide®.
- Metal bowls must be cleaned well after use of salt otherwise residue may oxidize and rust.

RESIN PRODUCTS

In order to retain the clean and crisp look of your resin bowl we recommend caring for your bowl with our General Care Instructions. These products dull the finish and cause the resin to become brittle. Once you feel your bowl has lived it's life with your salon please be sure to recycle.

COPPER BOWLS / FOOTRESTS

The beauty of copper metal lies in the way it oxidizes when exposed to the atmosphere. Simply rinse after each use to rid the surface of any soap or dirt, or use our General Care Instructions for a deeper clean. Dried water spots can be easily rubbed out with a soft towel. For a more thorough cleaning, wash occasionally with mild soap and a sponge. The lacquer will eventually wear off with time and usage. To help halt the look of patina you can simply rub oil over the item at the end of the day.

STAINLESS STEEL BOWLS / FOOTREST

Wipe clean with a soft moist cloth or wash with a dampened sponge in liquid soap and rinse. Refer to our General Care Instructions for cleaning.

POWDER COATED EXTERIORS

Using a mild cleaner, wipe clean with a soft sponge or cloth.

POWDER COATED ALUMINUM PEDICURE CARTS

Clean your pedicure carts with a damp microfibre cloth. Our General Care Instructions can be applied for a deeper clean.
